Most sensible folk stay behind the erected steel barriers, but a foolish few taunt the Bulls or have to take photos. First the cannons roar to mark the first Bull run, and 6 charge around the town.




Then a single entertaining bull is released and he moves around, but with a mind of his own, stopping to admire the view, and then the bystanders, me included.

He comes to admire the barrier I am standing in front of and luckily another foolish young man with orange shoes and red hat distracts him.






















A Professional Roper
